





Chapter 2 Operating Instruction

Connection



- 1 Connect one end of the BNC Cable to the terminals of the monitor.
- 2 Connect the other end of the BNC Cable to the VIDEO OUT
- 3 Then, plug in the power adapter into the power receptacle. The screen will be displayed when the monitor is on.

Installation

Before Installation

Read the cautions before installation:

- Make sure the installation location can support 5 times the total weight of the bullet camera.
- 2 Be careful not to let the cable be jammed in inappropriate places or to let the insulation covering of the cable peel off during installation. This may result in malfunction or a fire hazard.
- 3 Make sure that nobody is beneath the installation location, and remove the camera if anything urgent needs dealing there.

Installing the Camera


Installation process is illustrated as below

Step 1: Place the dielectrial paper on the wall/ceiling, which is to protect the camera from damage by conducted current. Then fix the fixed holder to the wall/ceiling with 4 screws. Pay attention to the cable trough. Put it in the direction of power supply if cables exit there.



Step 2: Attach the camera body to the fixed holder.







Step3: Fasten the camera body tightly by the gear on the locked ring, the installation is done.

Cautions for Installation

- 1 Allow the cable to pass through the hole in the middle of the fixed holder before mounting the camera to the fixed holder.
- 2 If passing through the side, the cable must be put at the cable trough first before the camera is mounted.

Adjustment of Monitoring Direction





This camera is with 3-axis gimbal design.

Loose the holder screw, the bracket screw, and the connector screw, then adjust the monitoring direction according to actual need.

After one direction is set, tighten that screw to fix.

Tighten all screws when the adjustment is done.

Adjustment of Function

Loose bottom cover screw to open the bottom cover

- 1 Use the video out port to connect the multi-tester with the camera, and check the image on screen.
- 2 Set the functions by OSD setup.
- 3 Rotate IR Illumination adjustment to adjust the IR illumination according to the exact need in different applications.
- 4 Adjust the focal length with the lens zoom level and lens focus level according to need. After you get the clear image, tighten those two screws.
- 5 After the adjustment is done, lock the bottom cover by tightening bottom cover screw.

Chapter 3 Typical CCD Phenomena

The following effects on the monitor screen are characteristic of CCD cameras. They do not indicate any fault with the camera.

Smear

This occurs when shooting a very bright object such as electric lighting, the sun, or a strong reflection. This phenomenon is caused by an electric charge induced by infrared radiation deep in the photosensor. It appears as a vertical smear, since the CCD imaging element uses an interline transfer system.

Vertical aliasing

When you shoot vertical stripes or lines, they may appear jagged.

Blemishes

A CCD image sensor consists of an array of individual sensor elements (Pixels), A malfunctioning sensor element will cause a single pixel blemish in the picture. (This is generally not a problem.)

White speckles

While CCD image pickup device is made by an accurate technique, imperceptible speckles may rarely come up on the screen due to cosmic rays and so on. This is connected to the principle of CCD mage pickup device, not a malfunction. And the white speckles are easy to come up in the following conditions.

- Using the camera in high temperature
- When turning up the gain

Blooming

This is a phenomenon is which the light from very bright objects appears to overflow into neighboring areas in an image.

Note

If strong light enters a wide area of the screen, the screen may become dark. This is not a malfunction. If this occurs, avoid strong light or adjust the lens iris to reduce the light amount.

Chapter 4 Common Troubleshooting

If encounter troubles in use of the bullet camera, please refer to the following instructions. For more information, please consult nearby local authorized distributor

Troubles	Solution		
No Video Output	Check the power supply, or the connection among the cable, camera and monitor.		
Malfunction	Check whether the camera is connected to the DC 12V power supply.		
Light Image	Adjust the display contrast of the monitor; Change the location if the camera is exposed to intense light.		
Dark Image	Adjust the Brightness.		
The situations below are not malfunction of the camera.			
Vertical Streak	It may appear when the camera is exposed to intense light.		
Fixed Image Clutter	When the camera is in high temperature environment, there may be fixed image clutter on the entire monitor screen.		
Jagged Image	When shooting at a ribbon-like object, a straight line or something of similar patterns, the image displayed on the monitor may be serrated.		

Chapter 5 Current Maintenance

- 1 In use of the camera, regularly clean the dust and dirt on the lens surface of the camera to keep good clarity of image.
- 2 Clean the camera with dry and soft cloth. For stubborn dirt, please wipe it with a cloth dipped in a little neutral detergent, and then dry the camera with cloth.
- 3 Be careful not to use volatile impregnant like thinner, alcohol, benzene or pesticide, etc. to clean the camera, for that can damage the surface coating, and even weaken the function and performance of the camera.
